What if my child is interested, but nervous about performing?

If your child isn't sure about stepping into the spotlight, no problem! They will have the first half of the school year to explore different things about the theater arts in our class, including acting, set design, lighting, make-up, costuming, and so much more. This will give us all ample time, students, parents/guardians, and me, to figure out how your child will be the most comfortable in participating in the spring production.



My child is interested in acting, but isn't a singer or dancer, can they still perform in a musical?

Yes! I have worked with children for years with very wide ranges of abilities on and off the stage. The first thing to consider about being in a musical is that there are a lot of ways to be in the show that don't involve a lot of singing or dancing. The second thing to consider is that everyone has the potential to sing and dance (Ali Stroker is taking Broadway stages by storm, playing leading roles in musicals in a wheelchair). We may not be Broadway bound just yet, but working together as a group will help us all grow our individual and unique talents.



What is the cost to participate?

There is no fee to join the club. Due to production costs, however, there will be fundraising efforts required for students and/or their families to participate in and each family will be responsible for purchasing something to contribute toward the production (i.e. their child's costume or something of similar value toward the set/prop completion if your child decides to be on crew and not act in the performance). This cost would be occurring in the spring (March or April) and should not exceed \$150. A detailed costume and purchasing guide will be provided well in advance of the production.
