

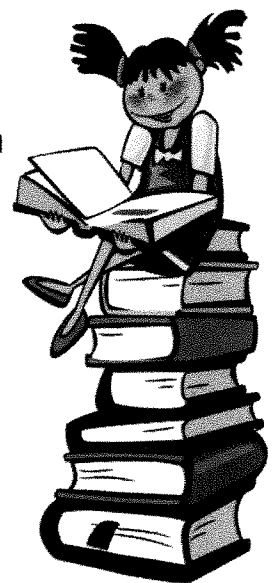
Summer Reading for Students Entering Grade 3

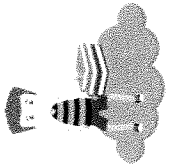

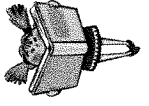
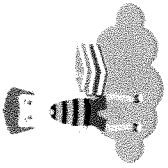
