Part Two: Short Response- While reading <i>Hatchet</i> , respond to the following questions in 1-2 complete sentences.	
1.	How old is Brian at the beginning of the novel, and why is he traveling to Canada?
2.	Why is Brian stuck in the woods, and what tools does he have to help him survive?
3.	What was "the secret" to which Brian's thoughts often wander?
4.	When Brian has to fly the plane himself after the pilot's heart attack, what prior experience helps him?
5.	Give two examples of dangers Brian encounters while surviving alone in the forest. How does he overcome them?
6.	Give two examples of tools Brian creates on his own in the forest. How do they help him survive?
7.	What are the consequences of the tornado destroying Brian's shelter and fire?
8.	What survival tools does Brian find in the wreckage of the plane towards the end of the novel, and how does he react to them?

2.	What do you think would have happened if Brian had found the survival pack much earlier? Would he be the same person he became under the book's circumstances?
