Dear Parent/Guardian,

If a parent finds it a necessity for their child to bring a cell phone to school, the parent/guardian will need to sign a permission form before the phone is brought to school. As per the Student/Parent Handbook, *"cell phones and all other electronic devices are to be turned into the homeroom teacher every morning; teachers will lock the phones in a lock box and return them to students at the end of the day."* The phone will remain turned off in the lock box for the duration of the school day, and it will be returned when school is dismissed.
